I N T R O D U C T I O N :

Santiago Canyon College (SCC) scholarships are awarded on the basis of criteria established by donors. Please refer to the specific description for each scholarship. Scholarships are available to SCC graduating sophomores, SCC students transferring as a junior to a four-year college or university, and students who are continuing their education in academic programs at SCC. Scholarship assistance is provided by individual donors, national associations, local clubs, societies and businesses. All awards are based on the receipt of funding from donors. Scholarship recipients are selected by the Scholarship Selection Committee, unless indicated as a "donor selected" scholarship, in which case the recipients are selected by their donor.

NOTICE REGARDING SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS OVER \$799: When a recipient receives \$800 in a scholarship, their funds will be disbursed in two payments over two terms (fall & spring). The SCC Scholarship Program will work with you to determine the disbursements. We will attempt to notify all scholarship award recipients by mail or email using the information on your scholarship application. **If you change any contact information, please notify SCC Scholarship Program Office at 714.628.4793 and update your information on WebAdvisor.**

R E Q U I R E M E N T S :

Applicants MUST:

- Be registered for classes at Santiago Canyon College
- Have declared SCC as their "Home Campus" **AND**
- Be enrolled at SCC in a minimum of six (6) units for the fall 2011 and a minimum of six (6) units the Spring 2012 semesters, **AND**
- Have completed a total of twelve (12) college units by the completion of the Spring 2012 semester. For purposes of this application process, all academic information (**including course-work completed at other colleges**) **MUST show on your SCC transcript by the deadline date of March 1, 2012.**

In addition to the SCC Scholarship Program requirements, each scholarship has its own criteria, read **carefully** through this book to determine if your qualifications match the criteria listed. **You may apply for any and all scholarships for which you meet the criteria.** If you have any questions, check with the SCC Scholarship Program Office (Room E-104).

List **ALL** scholarships you are applying for on the Application Cover Page (**Pages 20 & 21**). **Fill out the ENTIRE application.** A Scholarship Application (**Page 20**) is included at the back of this handbook for your convenience. You may make copies of this form. **REMEMBER: It is YOUR responsibility to submit a complete, SIGNED application to the SCC Scholarship Program Office (Room E-104) ON OR BEFORE the MARCH 1, 2012 deadline date. Be sure to include ALL required attachments.**

R E C O M M E N D A T I O N L E T T E R S :

For most scholarships one (1) letter of recommendation is all that needs to be included in your Application Packet—Make sure to check the **specific** requirements of each scholarship you apply for. Some scholarships may require more than one recommendation letter, some require letters of recommendation from specific sources. Recommendation letters may come from an instructor, school advisor, a community leader, or an employer. **PLEASE NOTE:** Students **MUST** include a minimum of one—TO A MAXIMUM OF THREE—letters of recommendation in the Application Packet. **DO NOT INCLUDE MORE THAN THREE.**

If you prefer, there is a **Personal Recommendation Form** in this handbook (p.24), to be used **in place of** the traditional letter of recommendation, you do not need both. **Should you leave this form with an instructor, it is your responsibility to make sure that this form is sent to the SCC Scholarship Program Office (Room E-104) on or before the March 1, 2012**

AUTOBIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT/PERSONAL STATEMENT:

This is your opportunity to tell the Scholarship Selection Committee all about yourself. Discuss your future plans, why you need this scholarship, etc. In your statement be sure to touch on all of the scholarship qualifying criteria for every scholarship that you are applying for. Your packet must speak for you and answer any and all personal questions the committee may need to know about you. **Please limit this statement to ONE page.** It may be single-spaced. For more information about preparing this statement, or any other questions you may have, we suggest you attend a Scholarship Workshop. If you have questions, please contact the SCC Scholarship Program Office.

I M P O R T A N T :

BE SURE TO SIGN YOUR APPLICATION PACKET The SCC Scholarship Program Office is unable to obtain your transcripts or share application information if your application packet is unsigned. KEEP THIS BOOK. The overall guidelines and rules of competition are listed here for your reference. You may need to refer to them after the **March 1, 2012** deadline.

In the box below is an actual scholarship. We've taken the scholarship description apart line-by-line and provided an explanation.

ERNA BAER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

GPA: 2.5
INCOME: Financial information (1040) federal tax form required
STATUS: Continuing student at SCC in fall 2012
AWARD(S): One
AMOUNT: \$500
Requirements: All majors; demonstrated financial need, enrolled in 9 or more units.

ERNA BAER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Name of the Scholarship may refer to the donor, the category, etc. This particular scholarship was established as a memorial tribute to Erna Baer.

2

GPA: 2.5

GPA: (Grade Point Average) This is the minimum grade point average you must have in order to apply. This scholarship requires that your GPA be a minimum of 2.5 or better.

3

INCOME: Financial information (1040) federal tax form required

Income: This informs you whether or not you are required to provide proof of financial need (**by submitting yours/your parents most recently filed 1040.**) For this scholarship your financial information is required.

4

STATUS: Continuing student at SCC in fall 2012

Status: Refers to YOUR status as a student in the **fall of 2012**. If you are remaining here at SCC you are a "Continuing" student, otherwise you are a "Graduating/Transferring" student. For this scholarship you must be a Continuing student at SCC in fall 2012.

5

AWARD(S): One

Awards: Indicates the number of recipients to be awarded for this scholarship. For this scholarship there is only one.

6

AMOUNT: \$500

Amount: Refers to the amount each award will be. The amount of this scholarship is \$500. This award will be given in one amount of \$500 in fall 2012.

7

Requirements: All majors; demonstrated financial need, enrolled in 9 or more units.

Requirements: This section refers to the criteria you must satisfy in order to qualify for this specific scholarship. For this particular scholarship you may be majoring in any subject, you must include a 1040 federal tax form to demonstrate financial need, and be enrolled in 9 units or more for each semester of the award.

Fund a Scholarship Legacy

The SCC Scholarship Program offers an easy and convenient way for individuals, service clubs or business donors to assist students who are committed to helping our students succeed and who are building their future at **Santiago Canyon College**. A scholarship can also serve as a distinctive tribute, memorial, or legacy to honor a donor or a loved one and support helpful pathways to our future community through the positive contributions of our SCC scholarship recipients. Scholarships are awarded annually on a competitive basis to incoming freshmen, students continuing their studies at Santiago Canyon College and to students transferring to four-year colleges and universities. Donor payments are due in April, and awards are announced at the Annual Scholarship and Awards Ceremony held in May. Payments are made to student recipients upon verification of enrollment for the upcoming 2012-2013 school year.

Giving Opportunities:

Therefore, a student enrolled in four classes can estimate that their textbook costs alone could exceed \$500.
